**Sub: Strengthening of Security Wing under Intelligence Directorate by
augmentation of manpower – Creation of posts thereof**

**(2) Proposal of Intelligence Directorate, Odisha and subsequent observations
of State Police Headquarters in file : SW-OE-MISC-0001-2023**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of Governor for creation of 203 posts in various ranks, as mentioned at **Annexure**, in different categories in level of pay mentioned against each therein and other allowances sanctioned by Government from time to time.

2. Since regular training and skill upgradation are critical aspects in high risk proximate security duties; the said posts are being created to ensure such police personnel are engaged in active duty on rotational basis and training on continuous basis.

3. The afore-mentioned newly created posts shall be filled up in a transparent manner following relevant recruitment rules and provisions of ORV Act.

4. Equal number of posts of Sepoys / constables as deputation reserve in Battalions (maximum 72) shall be created, upon their deployment to Security Wing, following prescribed procedure for the purpose.

State Police Headquarters is advised to depute the Sepoys / Constables from the organization under which these posts would be created.

5. The outsourcing of required services of Attendants, Cooks and Vistys for the newly created Security Training Centre (*meant for imparting dedicated induction and refresher training to police personnel of Security Wing*) is to be made purely on man-hour basis for a period of one year following relevant guidelines of Finance Department made in this regard from time to time by selecting an agency in a transparent manner with following stipulations:


- a. This shall be strictly outsourcing of services on man-hour basis and not engagement of manpower.
- b. A comprehensive service contract shall be made with the service providing agency, so that future litigation relating to regularization of service would be avoided.
- c. The scope of work shall be specific and clearly defined.
- d. The period of contract shall be maximum for a period of 2 years which can be extended for another period of one year subject to satisfactory performance. After end of the contract period, fresh tender shall be floated for selection of agency well ahead before the end of contract. Under no circumstances shall the contract be extended beyond 3 years.
- e. No ID Cards shall be issued by the procuring entity. In case of requirement, same shall be issued by the agency only.
- f. The service providing agency shall have valid GSTIN.

6. The charge is debitable to appropriate Units of Administrative expenditure under Head 'Demand No. 1 – 2055 – Police- EOME – 101 – Criminal Investigation and Vigilance.'

7. This has been concurred in by the Finance Department in their file FIN-GS1-CADRE-0049-2018.


